Government is pleased to direct that the
following should be added after rule 7(ii) of the Government
Resolution, Education and Labour Department No. SSN-3470/
41845-G, dated the 21st December, 1971.

*7(iii) The Period spent by a teacher on any training course
approved by Government as recruitment qualification for
appointment as a teacher in non-Government/Secondary Schools
alongwith adjoining vacations either on deputation by mana-
gement or by resignation or termination of service or on
leave without pay will not constitute a break in service
for the purposes of pension. This period should not, however,
be treated as duty period for the purposes of pension.

2/- The Director of Education Ahmedabad should be
requested to see that necessary instructions in the matter
are issued to all concerned, immediately.
